The Department of Urology offers the full range of diagnostic, conservative and surgical urology as a tertiary centre and works closely with the interdisciplinary partner clinics of the Insel Group.

Oncological therapies are a focus of the Department of Urology, which is to be further strengthened. These therapies are carried out on an interdisciplinary basis in a prostate and uro-oncological centre certified by the German Cancer Society (DKG).

As a seasoned surgeon with several years of experience in leading positions in a university urology department, the new incumbent is expected to competently represent the entire field of clinical, scientific and teaching disciplines; to network academic urology in the clinic as well as in teaching and research; and to strengthen and further develop the sub-specialities of urology.

The position is to be filled by an internationally recognized individual with a proven research profile and a talent for innovation. Furthermore, cooperation between clinical and basic science-oriented research groups is an important strategic goal of the Faculty of Medicine. For this reason, an interest in translational research is essential. Regular publication activities and the successful acquisition of competitive third-party funds are a prerequisite.

You are an excellent surgeon with a proven field of expertise in surgical oncology.

Management and leadership experience in complex, interdisciplinary organisations with appropriate business knowledge and a high degree of integration and teamwork skills as well as a pronounced social skills are essential. In addition, you are actively involved in implementing gender equality and diversity-relevant measures in your clinic.

Strong communication skills are expected. You have a good knowledge of German, French and English or are willing to acquire this.

A post-doctoral lecturing qualification (habilitation) or equivalent academic credentials as well as specialist medical qualifications in surgical urology (or equivalent) are required. Teaching skills and an interest in innovative and contemporary teaching and learning concepts as well as a strong commitment to the promotion of young talent and equality are expected.
