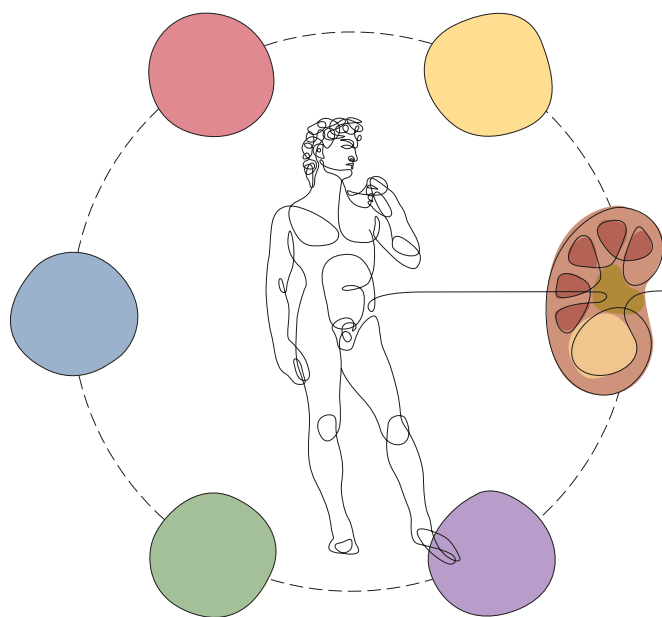

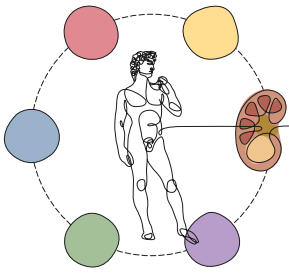

RATIONALE

Contemporary management of patients with localized and metastatic renal cell carcinoma (RCC) requires a multidisciplinary, holistic mindset. The field of RCC is rapidly evolving thanks to major changes in diagnostic and therapeutic strategies. A multispecialty approach to RCC is now essential to reach the paradigm of precision oncology and to align treatment options to patient values and preferences.

In this dynamic scenario, the first edition of the **Florence Multidisciplinary Expert Meeting on Renal Cell Carcinoma** will provide a unique, updated overview of the latest advances in the field of diagnosis and management of localized, locally-advanced, and metastatic RCC.

The meeting will gather a group of renowned European experts from multiple disciplines (urology, medical oncology, radiation oncology, radiology, and many others) to discuss the most updated evidence and controversies related in the field, following a modern and pragmatic framework leveraging open debates and fruitful discussion.
